WHAT IS UNIVERSITY EXPLORATION DAY?

Primarily in support of schools attending the Cardboard Boat Race, the University Exploration Day is an opportunity for students to access the university campus in the areas of Arts & Science and the Dhillon School of Business. The intention behind offering these two events on the same day is to maximize the investment of resources related to travel and supervision on the part of our smaller, rural schools. Initially, only those schools participating in Cardboard Boat Race will be offered the chance to register for the University Exploration Day. Any remaining spots will be made available to those schools without a CBR team.

This event can accommodate up to 100 students. Students will spend the morning exploring in either the Faculty of Arts & Science, or in the Dhillon School of Business. They will then cheer on the boat race teams as they race across the pool and compete in the weight challenges. Once the races are done, the students will round out their day learning more about the University of Lethbridge.

Faculty of Arts and Science: Join the Faculty of Arts & Science for a hands-on, engaging morning! On the day of the event, students will sign up for 2 of the following 6 sessions:

- Try your hand at coding and robotics
- Enter the lab and put your mixing skills to the test
- Explore the micro world with iGEM
- Learn about the science of kinesiology and use motion capture technology and simple experiments to understand what sends industrial athletes to the thrill of victory or the agony of defeat
- Dig deep into the wonderful world of archaeology
- Try a new angle on puzzles and problem solving

Dhillon School of Business: Join the Dhillon School of Business for a hands-on, engaging morning! Students will attend both of the following sessions:

- Try your hand at buying and selling stocks. Learn how to buy and sell shares and see whether you make a million or lose your shirt!
- Find out what it takes to run your own business. Try the business simulation for starting and running a new business and see how well you do!

Target: Grade 7-12 students, not participating in the Cardboard Boat Race, interested in exploring the Faculty of Arts & Science or Dhillon School of Business.

SUPERVISION

Schools must have at least 1 supervisor, with a cell phone, on the University of Lethbridge campus at all times, in the event of an emergency. This can be the same supervisor as the Cardboard Boat Race, however, if this is the case, that supervisor must stay in the First Choice Savings Center and not move with the University Exploration Day students.

Supervisors can be teachers, administrators, parents and/or drivers.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Teachers from schools participating in the Cardboard Boat Race will request spots for their schools. Requests will be received until November 4, 2022. Career Transitions will review all requests to determine how these seats will be allocated. Should these requests be granted and there are still additional spots available, a link will be sent to all schools on Monday, November 7, allowing them to request spots.

Once all requests have been gathered, schools will receive a registration form, outlining the number of spots that have been allocated in each area. Student names and emails will be requested.

- November 4, 2022 –Request link for participating CBR schools closes
- November 7, 2022 – All school request link opens (if space available)
- November 9, 2022 – All school request link closes
- November 16, 2022 - School-specific registration form sent
- November 28, 2022 – Deadline for student names and contact information

Spots at the event are NOT guaranteed through the request form – please wait until you receive your school-specific registration form to confirm your number of spots.
