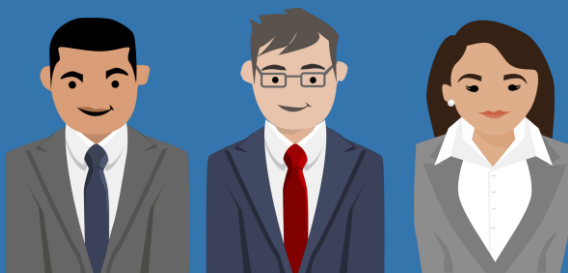
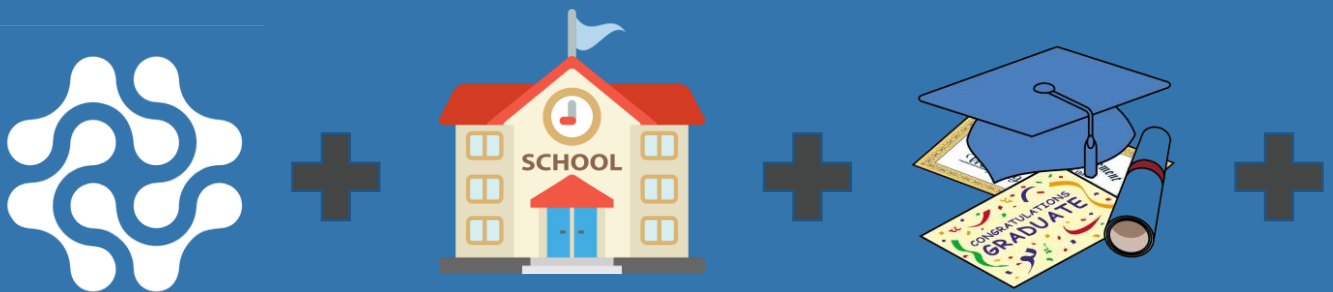

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WHAT IS EPIC DAY?

EPIC DAY is a large-scale, 2-part, career exploration event that features a variety of career pathways for students to explore. With your participation, we will introduce 1200 high school students to these pathways in a meaningful and impactful manner. Industry partners can be involved in 3 different ways:

Time: 9:00am – 2:30pm

Target: Southern AB students, primarily those in Grades 9-10 who are in full exploration mode



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OPTION 1 – CAREER CONFERENCE EXHIBITOR

Option 1: Host a booth at EPIC DAY Career Conference at Exhibition Park and showcase your occupation.

Hosting a booth involves:

- **Meeting** with us by phone to discuss your booth and interactive idea,
- **Developing** a 20-minute interactive, hands-on session for groups of 6 students,
- **Delivering** your session to a total of 10 groups of 6 students assigned to your "Exploration Zone" on the day of the event,
- **Inspiring** youth to consider future careers by sharing important information about your occupation/business/ industry, and
- **Building** your future talent pipeline!

POTENTIAL IMPACT

- Maximum student capacity at the event will be 1200
- Each Exploration Zone will consist of 5 exhibitors who will interact with 60 students throughout the day

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OPTION 2 – BUSINESS TOUR HOST

Option 2: Educate youth and showcase your business by providing an on-site tour.

Hosting a business tour involves:

- **Meeting** with us by phone to discuss your tour ideas,
- **Developing** a 1 to 2 hour tour, ensuring that the different roles in your business are included,
- **Delivering** the tour to a group of students assigned to your business on the day of the event,
- **Inspiring** youth to consider future careers by sharing important information about your occupation/business/ industry, and
- **Building** your future talent pipeline!

POTENTIAL IMPACT

- You decide how many students you would like during your business tour! Schools will be registering students in cohorts of 6 so tour group sizes will be in multiples of 6.

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OPTION 3 - SPONSOR

Option 3: Sponsor EPIC DAY

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: *Can I host a tour in the morning and attend the Career Conference in the afternoon?*

A: No – the Career Conference is a full day commitment. If you attend the Conference, we need you there all day for both the morning and afternoon sessions.

With the tours, you do have the option to offer tours in just the morning or afternoon, or both.

If you have available staffing, your business can attend the Career Conference and host tours.

Q: *Will there be an open time at the Career Conference for students to freely wander between Exploration Zones?*

A: No – there isn't time in the day for this to happen. Also, our experience in conducting an open career fair has taught us that this format does not add to the value of the experience for the students as they tend to just do a “fly-by” of booths, and do not engage in a productive manner.

Q: *What happens if I register now but cannot make it in the end?*

A: Due to the structure of the event, we do require your commitment! At the Career Conference, each Zone is set up with 5 exhibitors and 5 groups of 6 students in attendance. If an exhibitor were to back out at the last minute, 60 students would miss out on the opportunity to learn about a 5th career and would be totally unengaged for 20% of the event.

With the Business Tours, schools develop their transportation plan based on the tour that we set up for them. If a business can no longer accommodate a tour, the school is left trying to fill half their fieldtrip day.



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A FINAL NOTE FROM STUDENTS...

Here are some comments from students who attended the Career Conference last year:

- *I liked that the exhibitors could explain what they do, they were very interactive with us and answered any questions we had.*
- *It was a super fun experience. I had the opportunity to put PPE on and try something that I had never tried before, or even thought of trying, so it was cool. I liked that we could be very hands on and not just listen to them talk.*
- *It was very interesting to learn about careers that I had never considered or even heard of.*
- *The people showing us the displays were very nice and explained things clearly. The display was also a lot of fun and actually made me consider what the job would be like.*
- *I liked how I was able to gather information about different occupations, even if I knew I wouldn't pursue them. In my opinion, it's just as important to learn that you won't like something as it is to learn that you do. Either way, you are gathering more information about the career you would like to pursue and getting closer to figuring out what that career is.*
- *I liked that there were demonstrations and experiments we could do.*
- *Even if you don't do one of the occupations, you still learn a lot and opens your mind to way more things.*
- *I liked that they gave us things to do so that we didn't just have to listen.*
- *I learned exactly what career I would like to have!! I had no idea what I wanted to do after high school, but now I do!*
- *Basically, if you have an interest or passion, there is almost always a career that can occupy your passion for that certain thing.*

Here are some comments from students who attended Business Tours last year:

- *It helped me see that there is a lot of jobs within a single business.*
- *It was fun and you see that there are a lot of different things you can do in one workspace.*
- *Many people who work there have little to no experience when they start.*
- *I learned how many people it takes to run a business like that is a lot, and there are a lot of different divisions.*
